



Thank-you for your purchase of a **patent pending Cannagar Solutions cigar mold**. This aluminum represents refinements of hundreds of molds. We are also very proud that these are “Made in the USA”. Even the aluminum is created in the USA. Since they are aluminum, they should last for many years. I would **suggest washing them thoroughly before the first** use to insure any contaminants from manufacturing through shipping have been removed. Use dish soap and warm/hot water to wash.

Assemble the unit by aligning the two halves. When aligned they will be perfectly aligned at the top and bottom. Put the hex head bolt in the hole from back to front of the mold and screw on the knob. Don't overtighten. Snug is good enough. Any harder and you could strip the bolt. Since these are CNC milled, we are within a .005mm tolerance.

You shouldn't have to treat these as they are anodized and Teflon® coated to create a non-stick surface. One of the advantages of aluminum molds is the product will not stick to the sides like wood. Another great feature with the aluminum, no transfer of product scents into the wood. Everything should remain within the cigar.

**To use:** Put the mold together and check/adjust alignment. Place skewer down through the mold into the skewer hole at the base of the mold. I'd suggest having the point stick out of the mold. Then push larger pieces, (1/4"-1/2"), of product down and around the skewer at the top. If you don't have our packer, most use the blunt end of a skewer or two to push and pack it down into the mold.



To ease packing in product, we designed a special tool that has an opening through the shaft so you can pack in material with the skewer still in place. The tool also helps keep the skewer in the middle. Pick one up, as they make a world of difference in packing the product in. See photo.

We also sell skewers that are guaranteed to fit the packer. Pick up a package for a better experience with our molds and packer.



Then be sure to pack it down hard. Do not use any other packing method other than your hand pressure. That will be enough to pack the product in. From there, you determine how long you want it in the mold. Dozens of ways to finish the cigar when you are done. Research and test what best works for you.
